Participants learn about start-up issues and address the competition, legal matters, marketing and financial management aspects. FastTrac® participants don't just learn about business, they work on their own business endeavors throughout the program. It is best suited for someone with some previous management, supervisory or business-related experience, or for a recently launched business that needs some fine-tuning in order to really make money.

How to participate at NO CHARGE...

- If registered with the Missouri Full Employment Council--*no charge**
- If not yet registered with FEC, Missouri Residents can register through the class and participant in the training at *no charge**

(* "No charge" the fee is covered by the Missouri Division of Workforce Development; if paying the full tuition fee, the cost is \$300)
